Eve will be coming to each center to meet the staff and talk about future training needs!

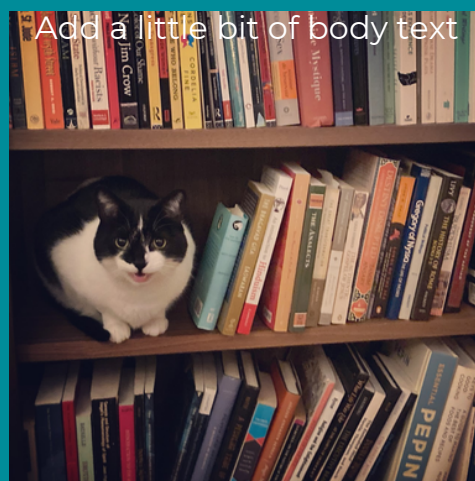
This position will work to consolidate KASAP training efforts and provide consistent training across coalition member programs and partners.

*AWARD DETAILS FROM PAGE 4:

Innovative Program Award: for programs creatively addressing awareness, education, and/or prevention specific to sexual violence. (RCCs may nominate themselves for innovative programming beyond the contractual and regulatory requirements)

SAAMy Award: for individuals who've made exceptional contributions to the anti-rape movement at either the local, regional, or statewide level

Fonetta A. Elam Award: recognition of exemplary clinical supervision for those working to address sexual violence

The Eileen A Recktenwald Collaborative Spirit Award: recognition for excellence in developing collaboration/partnerships that significantly benefit survivors and/or those working to help survivors.

It is okay if you don't know which award might be best for your nominee, the committee will consider all appropriate options.
